The event will feature a keynote address by Robert Smith, Director of the U.S. Department of Navy Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) Office of Naval Research. Following the keynote, there will be a discussion with representatives from the Defense Logistics Agency, the Boeing Company, Lockheed Martin, and Naval Surface Warfare Center on small business contracting and trends in defense spending. Local workforce boards and economic development groups will host workshops on how businesses can apply, enroll in, and stay up-to-date on various government programs.

Attendees will also learn if their company may be eligible to receive free consulting services through the newly awarded Southeastern Defense Transition Initiative grant from the U.S. Department of Defense Office of Economic Assistance. Learn how these services may help realign marketing and business development strategies in the wake of reduced defense spending.
